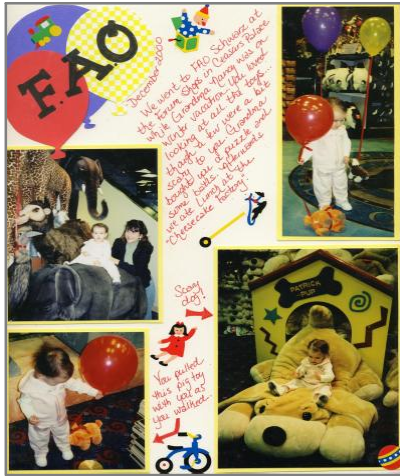

Effective July 1, 2006 the following adjustments will be made to my website:

- Custom "Album" Packages will no longer be available. All projects will be completed using per-page pricing. Please see the updates on the Custom Order page of my website. This new pricing will allow easier estimation of your final cost. And also give you a hand at keeping within your budget. There is no longer a "price-range" for either the Deluxe or Basic page; but a set price.
- Computerized journaling will now be included in the price. Or if you wish, a journaling box for you to add your own memories.
- Shipping will be free with orders over \$500.00 (U.S. Currency)
- International projects will now be accepted. Shipping prices vary.
- The 8.5 x 11 size album, has been changed within the industry. Now available is the 11 x 8.5...just a trendy twist on an old favorite.

I am offering a discount of 20% on all Custom Album orders until August 31, 2006. (Gift albums not included)
